**DESPITE MEETING CONSERVATION FORECAST, APRIL STATE REVENUES \$14M BELOW 2009**

Indiana State Budget Agency officials recently reported that April revenue numbers exceeded the December 2009 forecast, but were \$14 million lower than the same period last year.

Revenue collections have been below the budget plan for nine of the 10 months of the current fiscal year, consuming about half of the state’s \$1.3 billion in reserves in just the first 10 months of the two-year budget cycle.

According to the agency’s monthly revenue report, April collections from all revenue sources totaled \$1.4 billion, a drop of 1% from the same period last year. Sales tax collections were up \$30 million from the same period last year, while individual income taxes dropped \$18 million from last April’s totals.

In response to the continued revenue shortfalls, Gov. Mitch Daniels recently announced state agencies will be asked to spend 15% less than budgeted in the next fiscal year.
