### ArcelorMittal Announces \$63 Million Dollar Environmental Co-Gen Project

ArcelorMittal has announced a \$63  
million dollar project that will not only  
create 360 jobs related to the  
construction project, but also employ  
over 200 local trades personnel for 18  
months, and has a very positive  
environmental impact by decreasing  
340,000 tons of greenhouse gas  
emissions annually (the equivalent of  
taking approx 62,000 cars off the  
road!) Named: "The Indiana Harbor  
Energy Recovery & Reuse: 504  
Boiler Project", it will transform energy  
from flared gas for reuse at the No. 7  
Blast Furnace in East Chicago  
(Largest in North America), to a newly  
constructed boiler which will generate  
Steam and Electricity. The new boiler  
project is expected to generate  
350,000lbs of steam per hours, that  
will then be used to produce approxi-  
mately 38 megawatts of electricity.
